



Core School Agreement between RESET and [Name and Address of School]

RESET and [name of school] agree to a strengthened partnership to provide students exposure to Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) professionals and hands-on learning experiences in multiple fields of science as they advance grade levels.

RESET is a Washington, D.C. based IRS Section 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Its goal is to spark young students' enthusiasm for science and math while enriching knowledge through hands-on learning.

Program Overview:

RESET volunteers present hands-on science and math lessons in classroom settings to PreKindergarten, elementary, and middle school students in Washington DC, Maryland and Virginia. RESET programs include six sessions of 45 to 75 minutes each and a field trip with the same group of students. Schools and volunteers may agree to modify the particulars for individual programs, consistent with RESET and school objectives.

Partnership Responsibilities:

RESET will establish a high priority on: recruiting volunteers for [name of school]; offering RESET programs for students at multiple grade levels; placing RESET volunteers in optimal grade levels; working with teachers and volunteers to present programs that align with curriculum objectives and standards of learning; reaching out to parents; cooperating to assess RESET's impact on student attitudes towards, and achievements in, science learning.

[Name of School] will: Designate a responsive contact who is readily available to ReSET; place volunteers with teachers who share RESET's STEM objectives; host a meeting early each term for ReSET with the Principal or designee to review the past semester and plan for the semester ahead; host meetings for volunteer/ teacher teams early each term to develop classroom plans and schedules; assist RESET to place volunteers at optimal grade levels; facilitate interaction between RESET and parents/guardians; cooperate to assess RESET's impact on student attitudes towards, and achievements in, science learning; provide RESET volunteers with teacher feedback on their programs, including RESET Teacher Evaluation Forms.

The signatures below signify understanding and acceptance of the provisions of this Memorandum Agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either party with notice to the other party.
